TECH TIPS

COMMON DRIVESHAFT PROBLEMS

VEHICLE VIBRATION

May be caused by excessive wear of the CV joint or splines.

LOUD CV JOINT

A clicking noise when turning or accelerating often results from a worn CV joint.

A clunking noise when accelerating or decelerating is can indicate a worn inner CV joint with excessive backlash or clearance.

A humming noise can occur from a lack of lubrication in the CV joint.
